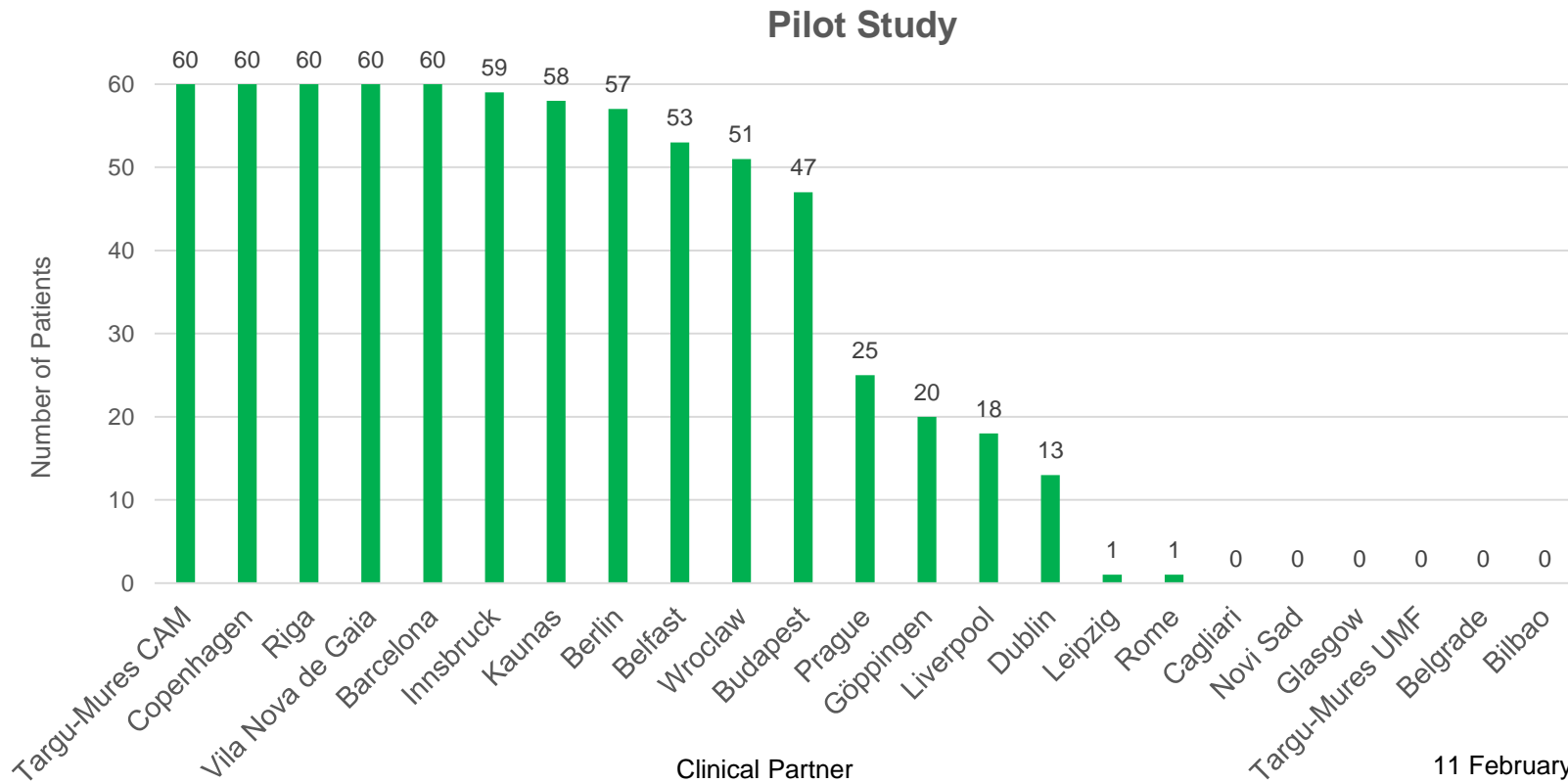

 - 3 points → Typical angina pectoris
 - 2 points → Atypical angina pectoris
 - 1 points → Non-anginal chest discomfort
 - 0 points → Other chest discomfort

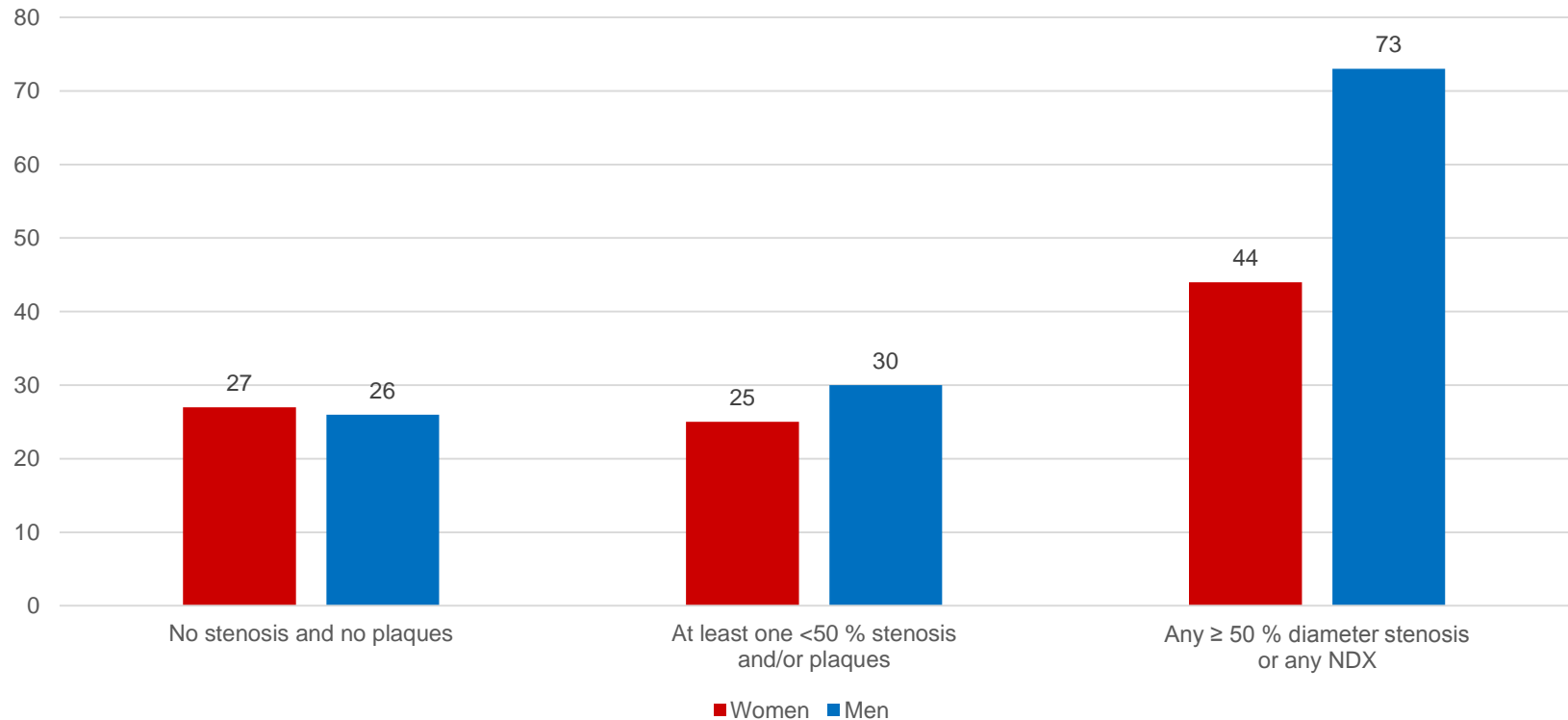

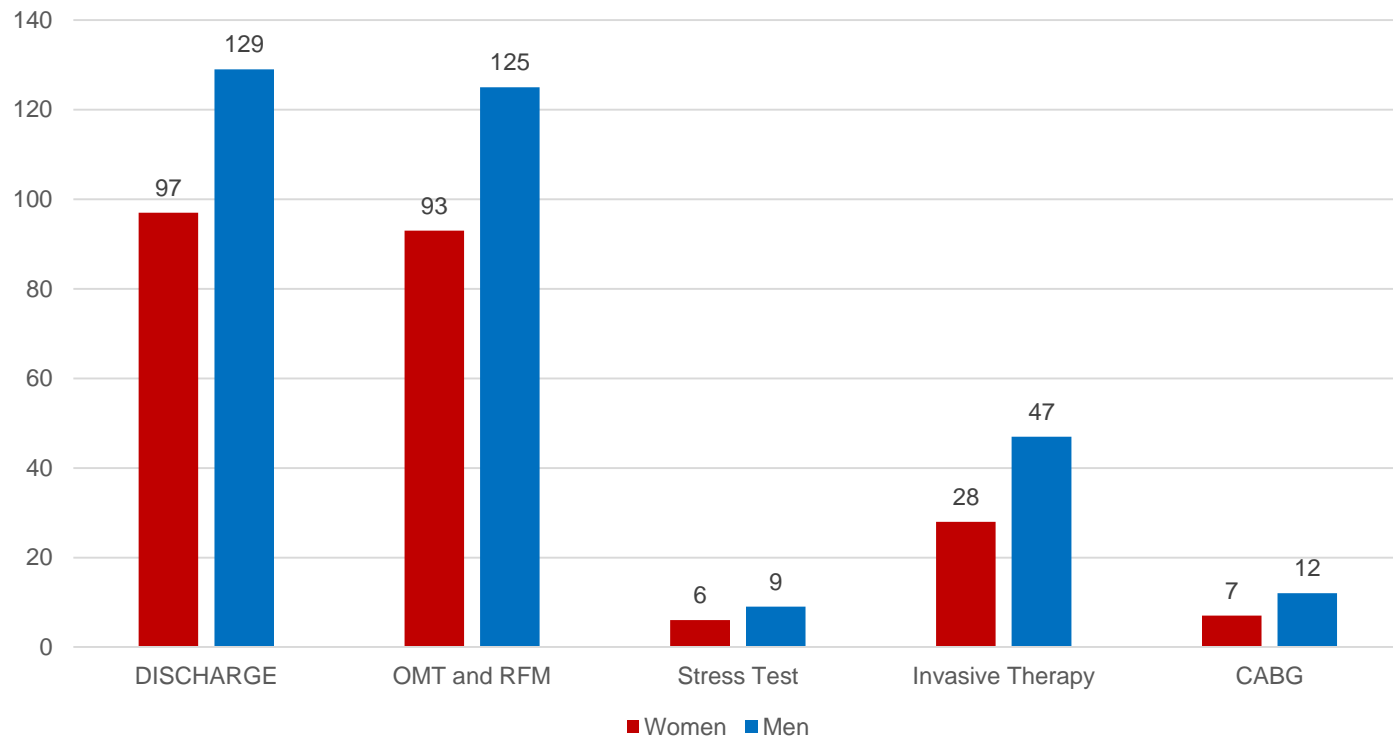

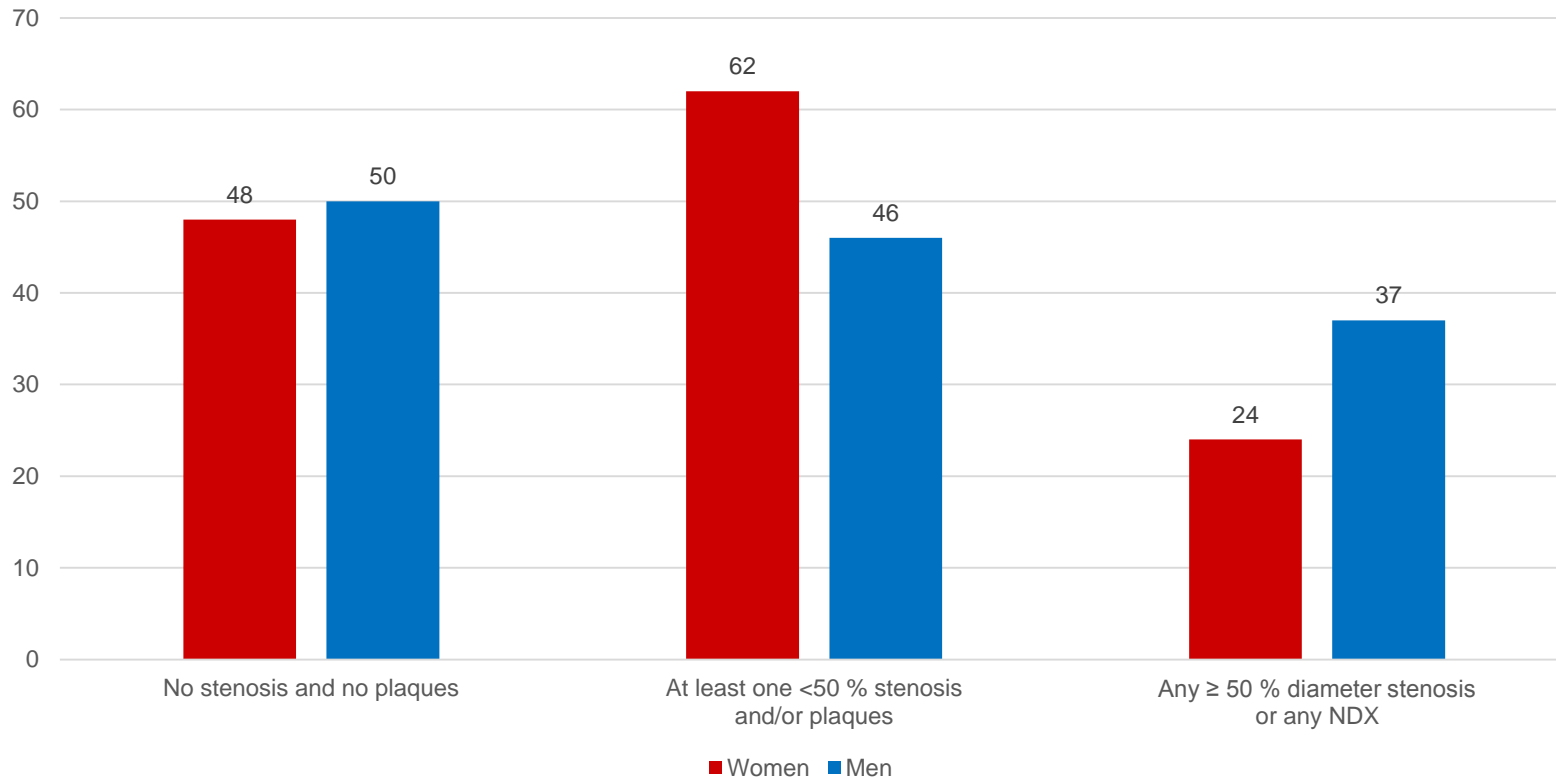

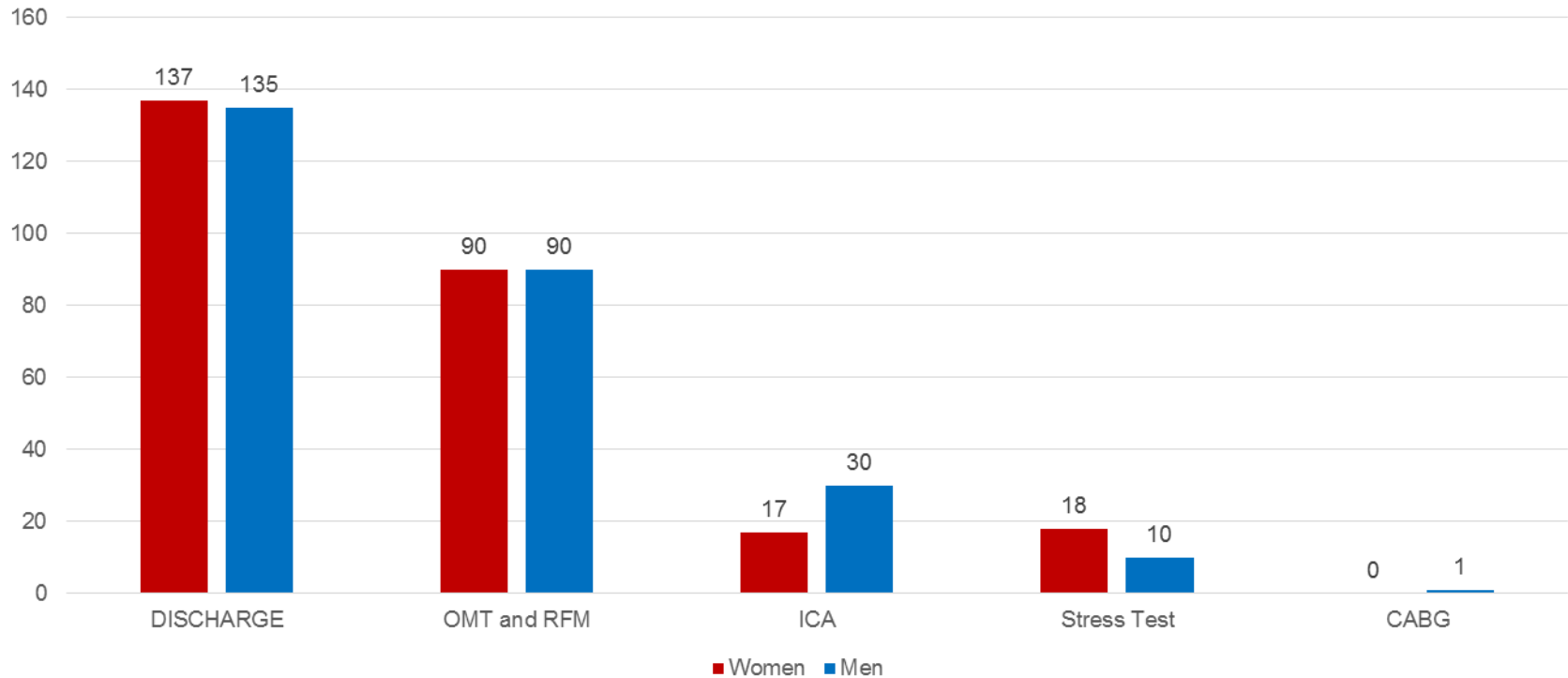
