The sites have to be informed in a timely manner and the decision has to be made again.</p> <p>AJ: The sites should be asked before the submission process.</p> <p>IG: At least one author per site has to be fixed. 	<p>MD: your suggestions for new publications are greatly appreciated and be added to the already predefined secondary analyses.</p>	<p>GF: We have to create a template for proposed publications.</p>

	<p>Major journal signalled interest in DISCHARGE primary analysis to MD a) How to proceed?</p>	<p>IG: I would answer to the journal in case this belonged to the top five famous journals.</p> <p>GF: We have to focus on journals which are read by everybody.</p>	

		<p>AJ: We have to focus on journals which have a high impact factor.</p> <p>RF: We have to focus on European journals not American journals.</p> <p>MD: The interest of this journal is based on the published CADMAN study. The CADMAN study includes short-time and long-time safety analysis: Will the journal wait for the publication of the primary analysis?</p> <p>GF: We could split the topics in two publications: 1. Short time safety analysis; 2. Long-time safety analysis and maybe discuss with the journal that in case we publish the short time outcomes in it the journal has to published also long-time safety.</p> <p>MD: PS has to do the statistical analysis if such on advance is feasible until March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017.</p> <p>GF: We have to focus on recruitment of patients in the study now, because the quality is important issue for a publication in a major journal.</p> <p>AJ: We have to do more dissemination and have to focus on the dissemination which is more effective to recruit better.</p> <p>GF: The most effective dissemination is to reach out for physicians, especially cardiologists.</p> <p>MD: Please send me an email with your additional comments or suggestions about the editor approach until March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017.</p>
